TESOL International Association Awarded Grant from the U.S. Embassy in India

Alexandria, Va. (10 February 2022) – The U.S. Embassy in India has awarded TESOL International Association (TESOL) a grant to provide the TESOL Core Certificate Program™ (TCCP) for 100 state government mentors from Telengana, Karnataka and West Bengal. Mentors will take the first part of the program virtually followed by in-person instruction in April 2022 focused on teaching adolescent learners. Additionally, 25 of the mentors will be selected to take the TESOL Training for Trainers course and support cascading training to secondary public-school teachers.

This grant builds on the existing partnership, which has provided TCCP to 150 state government mentors in partnership with the Regional English Language Office (RELO) and the Delhi State Ministry of Education (2017-2021). Mentors also receive a 2-year membership in TESOL.
